04-07-2006 New Release of Schema and User Documentation in week 2006/27

Follow-up of newsflashes 20, 21 & 22/2006

Schema release 1.3 has been enhanced to cater for the allocation of a new attribute "status" on data-unit level. This attribute represents the "field level change indicator" and will identify which update has triggered the exchange of the publication.

Refer to section 4.6 "Field Level Change Indicator" of release 1.3 of the User Documentation for detailed information on the implementation and the usage of this new attribute.

In the course of week 27 you will receive a special delivery in which the "field level change indicator" has been initialised. Please note that this delivery will have been produced from our TEST environment and may show one or two irregularities. This delivery will be clearly marked TEST.

Formal implementation of the "field level change indicator" has been foreseen for week 29/2006.

In relation to this new attribute, we have had to apply minor modifications to the schema. Refer to the User Documentation release 1.3, sections on :
