The Korean Patent Office will start to supply the translation of international patent applications into the Korean language.

The Patent document numbers will be within the normal series of B1 documents, but the application number will be 8 digits instead of 7 digits as used for the national patent applications. There is a prefix "7" for this kind of application. We will apply Kind-of-application code T for these documents.

national application:	yynnnnn,	e.g. 9712345
international application:	yy7nnnnn,	e.g. 97701234

and from year 2000 onwards

national application:	ccyynnnnn,	e.g. 200012345
international application:	ccyy7nnnnn,	e.g. 2000701234
