code meaning

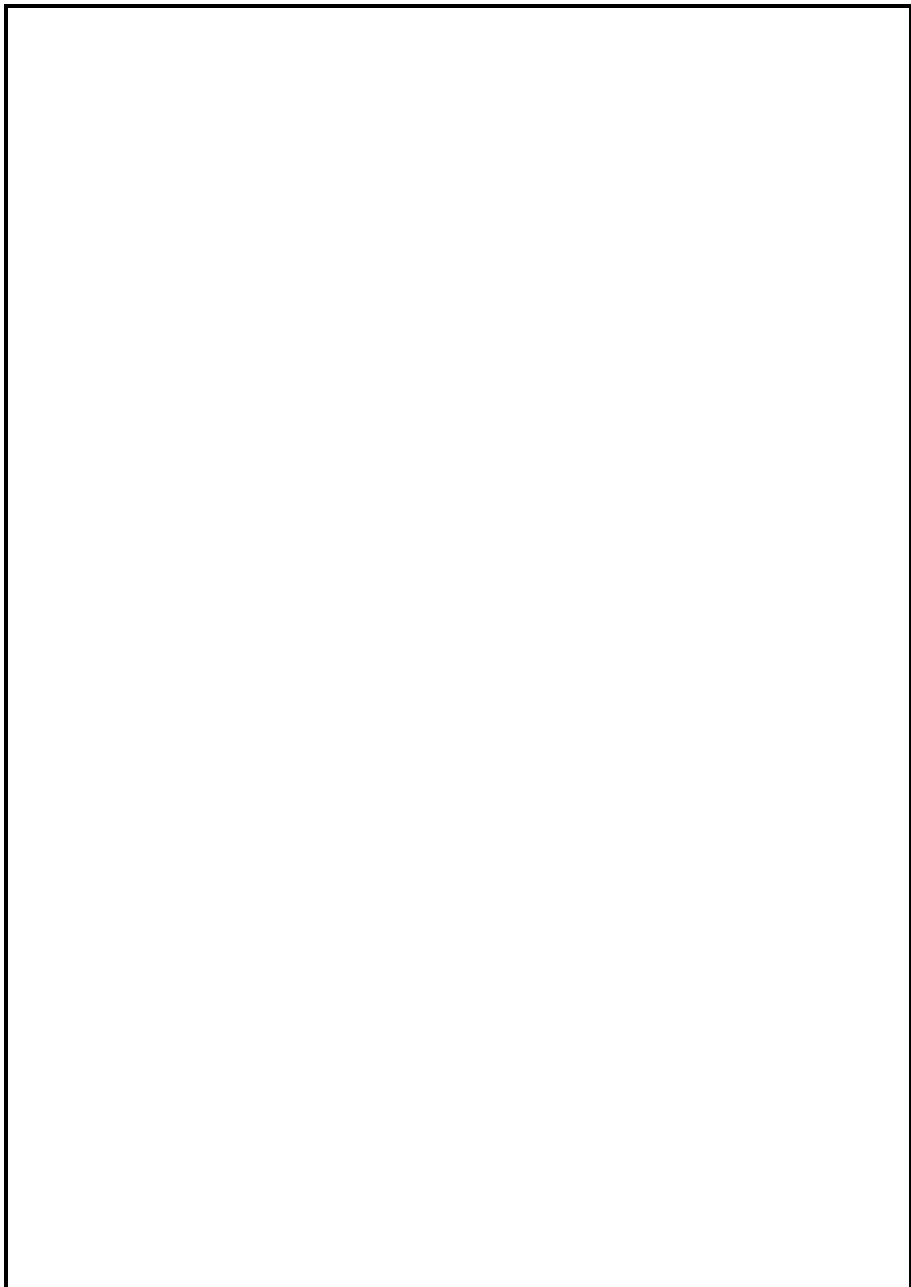
At any time within twelve months after the sealing of a patent, any person interested who did not oppose the grant of the patent may apply to the comptroller for an order revoking the patent on any one or more of the grounds upon which the grant could have been opposed. These grounds are: obtaining; prior publication, claiming or use; obviousness; not an invention; insufficiency; and for convention application, the application not made in time. The applicant for revocation must file a statement setting out his interest, full details of the case on which he relies and the relief sought. The onus of establishing 'interest' or 'locus standi' falls upon the person making the application for revocation. If the person fails to establish 'locus', the application is regarded as not being launched and is advertised as 'not entertained'.
