code meaning

At any time within twelve months after the sealing of a patent, any person interested who did not oppose the grant of the patent may apply to the comptroller for an order revoking the patent on one or more of the grounds upon which the grant could have been opposed. These grounds are: obtaining; prior publication, claiming, use; not an invention; obviousness; insufficiency; and for convention applications, the application not made in time. The applicant for revocation must file a statement setting out his interest, full details of the case on which he relies and the relief sought. The patentee must file a counterstatement setting out his response. Failure to file a counter-statement leads to the patentee's case being treated as undefended. The application is heard by the comptroller who may order revocation unless within a specified time the complete specification is amended to his satisfaction.
