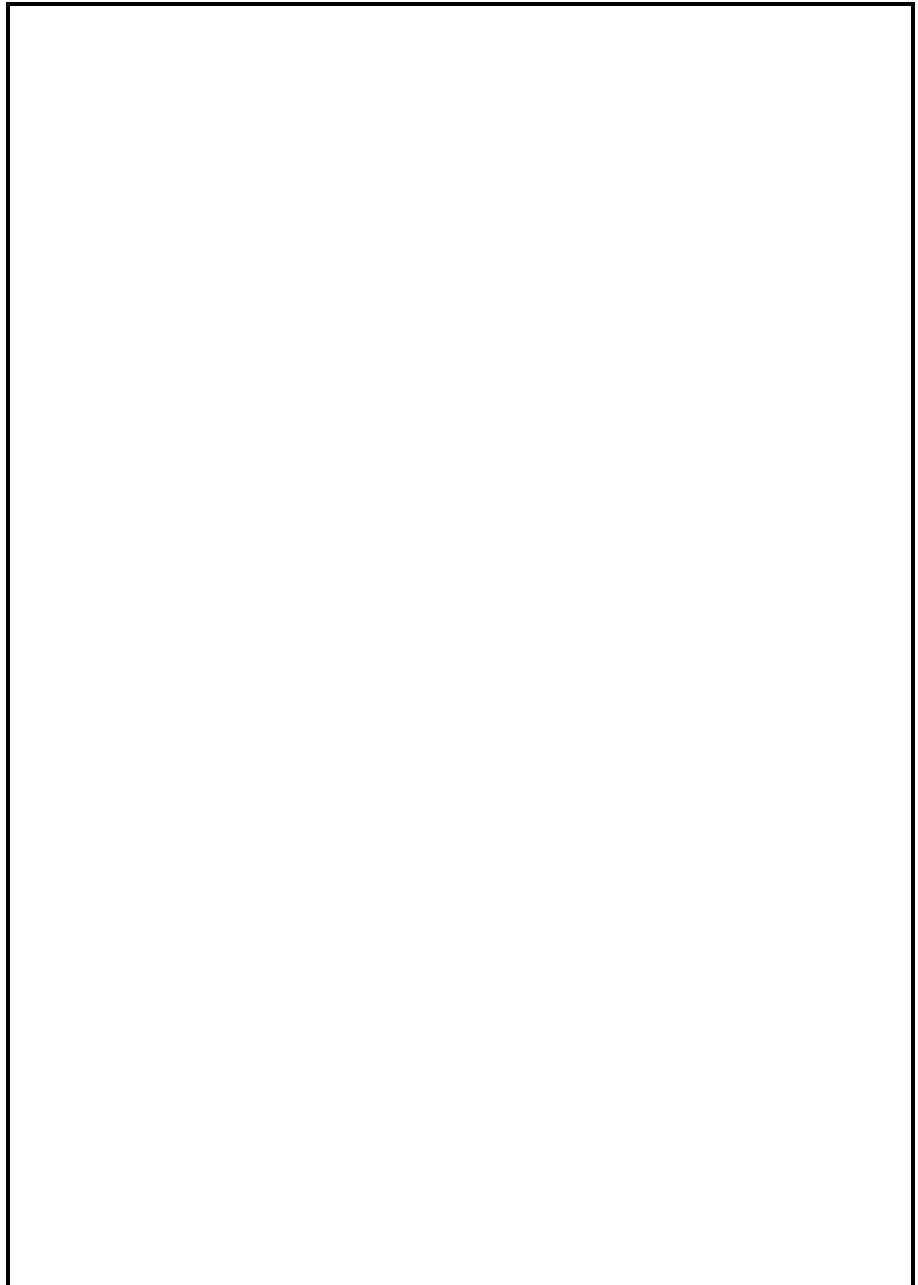
At any time within twelve months after sealing of a patent, any person interested who did not oppose the grant of the patent may apply to the comptroller for an order revoking the patent on one or more of the grounds upon which the grant could have been opposed. These grounds are: obtaining; prior publication/ claiming/use; obviousness; not an invention; insufficiency; and for convention applications, the application not made in time. The applicant for revocation must file a statement setting out his interest, full details of the case on which he relies and the relief sought. The patentee must file a counterstatement setting out his response. Failure to file a counterstatement leads to the patentee's case being treated as undefended. The application is heard by the comptroller and there is an appeal from any decision. In the event that an appeal is dismissed the decision of the comptroller stands and if that decision decided upon amendment of the specification, amendment slips are printed.
