Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

At any time within 12 months after sealing of a patent, any person interested who did not oppose the grant of the patent may apply to the comptroller for an order revoking the patent on any one or more of the grounds upon which the grant could have been opposed. These grounds are, obtaining, prior claiming, publication, obviousness, not an invention, insufficiency, and for convention applications, the application not made in time. Where a patentee is willing to submit to an order for revocation, he may avoid the risk of incurring further costs by offering to surrender the patent under Section 34. The offer will be advertised in the Official Gazette so that any person may oppose the surrender, but in the event that the offer is accepted the proceedings under Section 33 will be terminated and an order will be made revoking the patent.
