field meaning

Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

At any time after the Voluntary endorsement of a patent 'licence of right' the patentee may apply for cancellation of the endorsement. Cancellation is subject to the conditions that there are no existing licences or the licensees consent and that the patentee pays the balance of all renewal fees which would have been payable if the patent had not been endorsed. The application is advertised in the Official Gazette and any interested person may give notice of opposition to the application within one month from the date of the advertisement. The opposition is heard by the comptroller and there is an appeal from any decision. An application to cancel an endorsement 'licence of right' may be made by a person who claims that at the time of the endorsement the patentee was prohibited from granting further licences by a contract. The patentee may oppose the application and the opposition be heard by the comptroller. There is an appeal from any decision.
