code meaning

At any time after the expiration of three years from the date of sealing of a patent, any person interested may apply to the comptroller for a licence under the patent or for the patent to be endorsed licences of right. The grounds upon which the application may be made are: that the invention is not being commercially worked; that a demand for the patented article is not being met; that the working of the patent in the UK is being hindered by importation of the patented article; that the patentee is imposing unfair or unreasonably prejudiced conditions for the grant of a licence. The application is advertised in the Official Gazette and may be opposed. In the event that the application is withdrawn, then this too will be advertised.
