code meaning

So that the monopoly conferred by a patent does not operate against the public interest the comptroller has the power to endorse a patent 'licence of right', to grant, amend and cancel licences and to revoke the patent. Under Section 41 the comptroller may exercise these powers when the patent is for a food or medicine, a process for producing a food or medicine or an invention capable of being used as a surgical or curative device. The comptroller normally grants a licence on such terms as he thinks fit to any person interested who makes application. The licence is granted for no other purpose than to entitle the licensee to make, use, exercise and vend the invention as a food or medicine, or for the production of food or medicine or as part of a surgical or curative device.
