code meaning

If during proceedings under Section 14 of the Patents Act 1949 it is found that a complete specification contains an error, correction of the error may be made at the instance of the comptroller or at the request of a person interested. When the Office considers correction of the specification is allowable it is advertised in those cases in which it appears that the correction would materially alter the meaning or scope of the specification. Within one month after the advertisement in the Official Gazette any person interested may give notice of opposition accompanied by a statement setting out the interest, facts relied upon and the relief sought. The person seeking the correction may answer the statement and the case is heard by the comptroller. In the event that the correction is allowed this is advertised in the Official Gazette.
