code meaning

Any person may apply to the comptroller to revoke a patent on only the following grounds: invention not patentable; patent granted to person not entitled; specification is not clear enough to be performed; matter extends beyond that disclosed in the application as filed; scope of patent has been extended by an amendment not allowable. The comptroller may order unconditional revocation or, where one ground has been established to only a limited extent, that revocation will be ordered unless the specification is amended under Section 75 to his satisfaction. Any amendments requested are advertised in the Official Gazette and may be opposed, the comptroller considering the opposition in deciding whether the amendment or any amendment should be allowed. There is an appeal from any decision of the comptroller.
