Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

When a patent has ceased due to non-payment of a renewal fee, an application for restoration of the patent may be made to the comptroller within one year from the date on which the patent ceased. The application may be made by the proprietor or any person who would have had rights under the patent. The comptroller has to be satisfied that the proprietor took reasonable care to see that any renewal fee was paid and that the fee was not paid because of circumstances beyond his control. In the event that after filing the application the applicant does not file evidence in support of the statement made in the application, the application shall be deemed to have been withdrawn and advertised as such in the Official Gazette.
