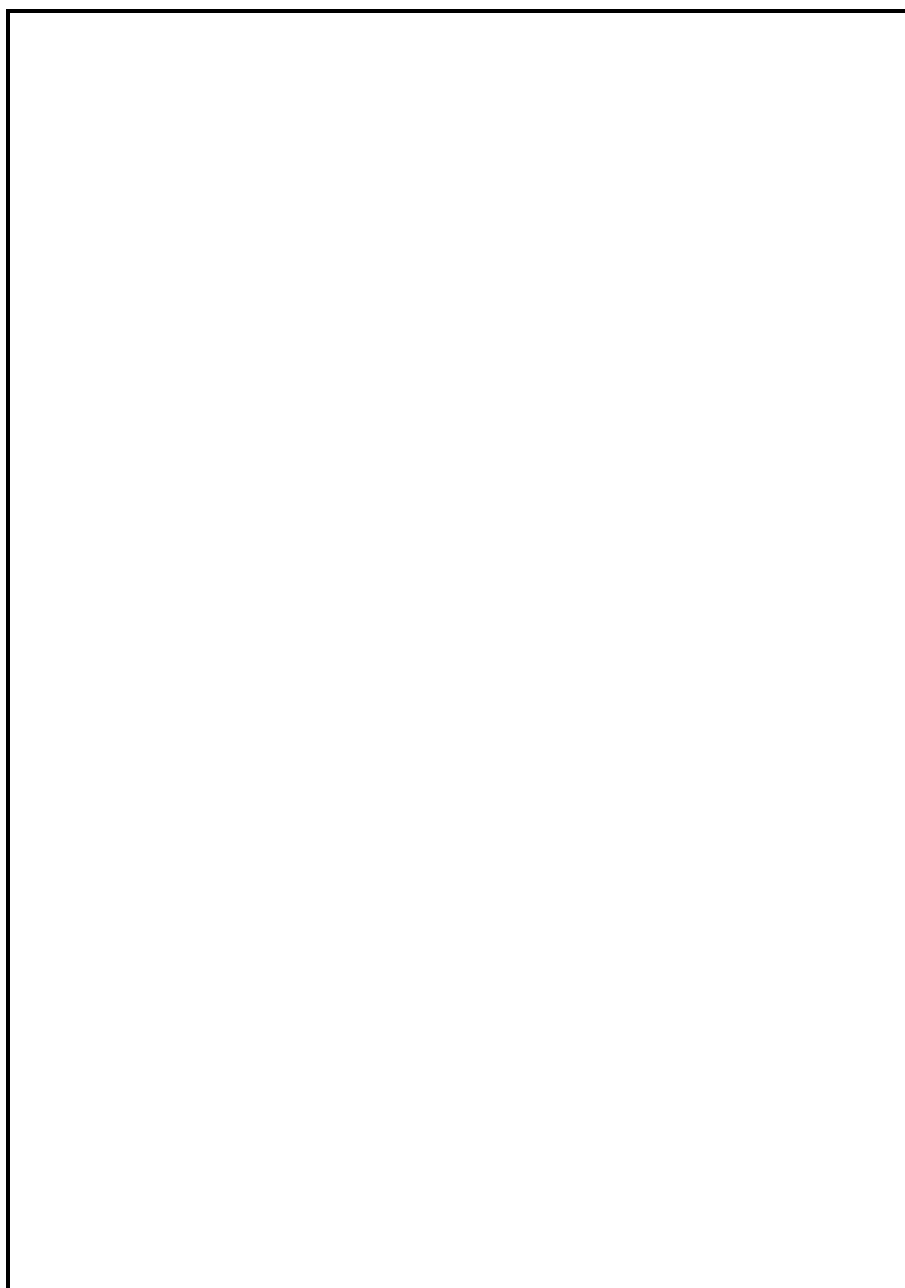
When a patent has ceased due to non-payment of a renewal fee, an application for restoration of the patent may be made to the comptroller within one year from the date on which the patent ceased. The application may be made by the proprietor or any person who would have had rights under the patent. The comptroller has to be satisfied that the proprietor took reasonable care to see that any renewal fee was paid and that the fee was not paid because of circumstances beyond his control. If the comptroller is not satisfied that a case has been made out the applicant is notified and a hearing may be arranged to decide the matter. Under Rule 100 any document filed before the comptroller may be amended, and any irregularity in procedure rectified, on such terms as he may direct. Thus for example, an application for restoration may be allowed to be withdrawn if the comptroller so directs.
