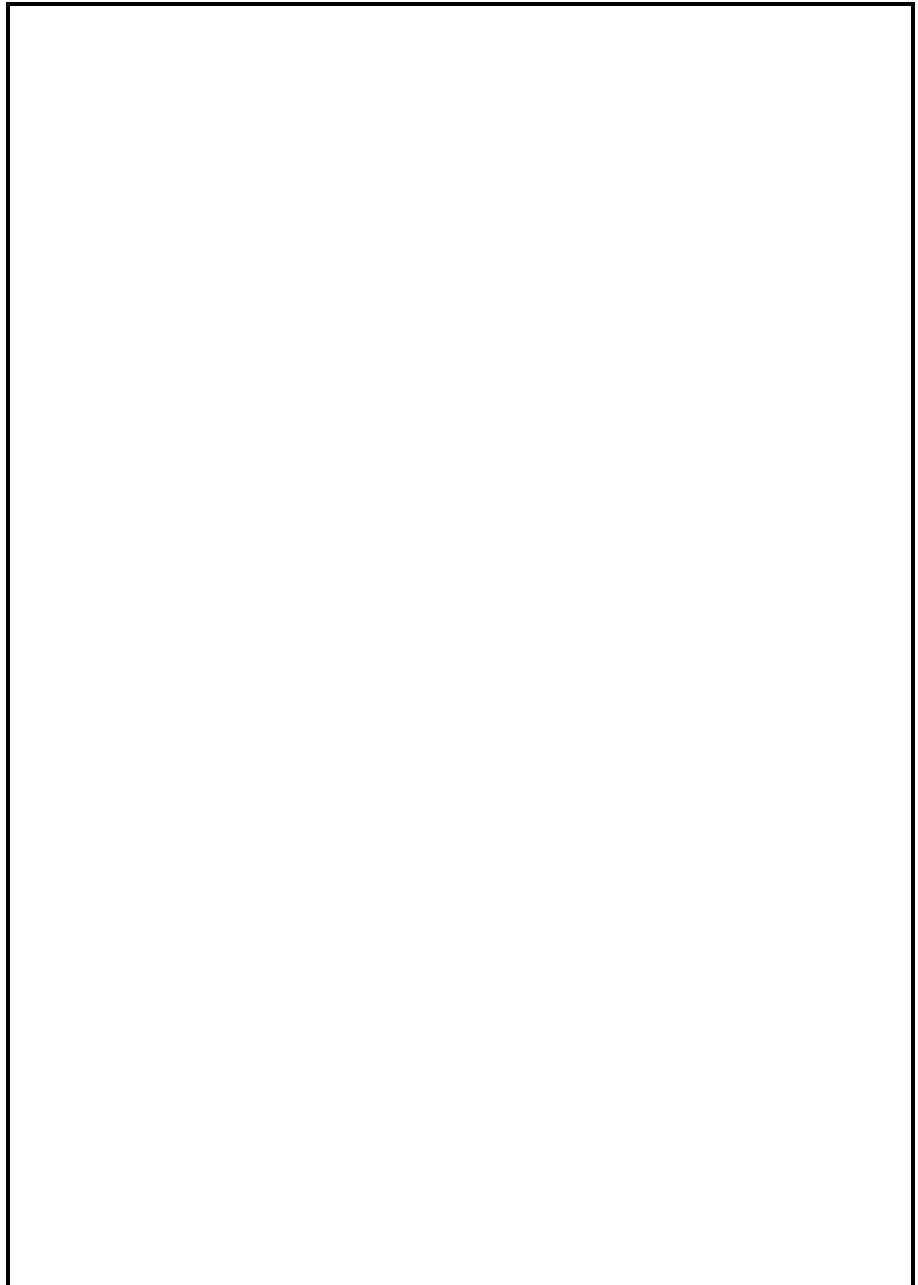
Under Section 27 of the Patents Act 1949, if a patent ceased due to non-payment of a renewal fee, an application for restoration of the patent may be made to the comptroller within three years from the date on which the patent ceased. The ground for restoration is that the comptroller must be satisfied that the failure to renew the patent was unintentional and a statement setting out fully the circumstances which led to the failure is required. In the event that the is refused an appeal lies from the comptroller's decision to the Patents Court. In the event that the appeal is dismissed then an appeal from this decision may be made to the Court of Appeal.
