code meaning

When a patent has ceased through non-payment of renewal fees (PCNP), an application for the restoration of the patent may be made within one year from the date on which the patent ceased by either the proprietor or any other person who would have been entitled to the patent, on the grounds that the proprietor took reasonable care to see the renewal fee was paid or that the non-payment was due to circumstances beyond their control. The application for restoration must be supported by evidence. If on this evidence the comptroller refuses the application, the applicant may within one month request to be heard in the matter, and if again refused, appeal from the decision to the Patents Court. If the Court decides not to hear the appeal then this decision will be advertised in the Official Gazette.
