code meaning

At any time within twelve months after sealing of a patent granted under the 1949 Patents Act, any person interested who did not oppose the grant of the patent may apply to the comptroller for an order revoking the patent on one or more of the grounds upon which the grant of the patent could have been opposed. The applicant for revocation must file a statement setting out his interest, full details of the case on which he relies and the relief sought. An offer to surrender may be made in response to an application for revocation. This may be opposed and the comptroller has to decide whether to accept the offer. His decision is advertised in the Official Gazette. The offer to surrender does not bring to an end the action for revocation.
