Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

The proprietor of a patent may at any time by notice given to the comptroller offer to surrender his patent. This notice is advertised in the Official Gazette and within three months from the date of the advertisement any person may give notice of opposition to the surrender. The notice of opposition must be supported by a statement setting out the facts relied upon and the relief sought. Within three months of the statement the proprietor must, if he wishes to continue with the surrender, file a counter-statement setting out the grounds on which the opposition will be resisted. The opposition will be heard by the comptroller and there is an appeal from any decision to the Patents Court. In the event that there is no opposition and the offer to surrender is accepted by the comptroller, then this will be advertised in the Official Gazette. The surrender takes effect from the date of the advertisement.
