Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

When a patent has ceased due to non-payment of a renewal fee, an application for restoration of the patent may be made to the comptroller within one year from the date on which the patent ceased. The application may be made by the proprietor or any person who would have had rights under the patent. The comptroller has to be satisfied that the proprietor took reasonable care to see that any renewal fee was paid and that the fee was not paid because of circumstances beyond his control. If the comptroller is not satisfied that a case for restoration has been made out he will notify the applicant accordingly and if within one month there is no reply he will refuse the application. If however the applicant replies and requests a hearing the comptroller after giving the applicant an opportunity to be heard decides whether the application shall be allowed or refused. The order for restoration is notified in the register of patents.
