code meaning

At any time after the grant of a patent its proprietor may apply to the comptroller for an entry to be made in the register of patents to the effect that licences under the patent will be granted as of right. The comptroller must give notice of the application to any person registered as having a right in or under the patent. If the application is opposed the opposition proceedings are heard by the comptroller and there may be an appeal from his decision to the Patents Court.
