Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

At any time after the expiration of three years from the date of the grant of a patent any person may apply to the comptroller for 1) a licence under the patent, or 2) an entry in the register to the effect that licences of right are available under the patent, or 3) where the applicant is a government department, for the grant of a licence to a specific person. The person must make the application on one or more of the grounds: that the patent is not being worked; the demand for the product of the patent is not being met; that the patent is being prevented or hindered from being worked; that a licence is being refused; that conditions imposed by the proprietor for the grant of a licence are unfairly prejudiced. In the event that proceedings in the application are adjourned sine die this is advertised in the Official Gazette.
