code meaning

At any time after the expiration of three years from the date of the grant of a patent, any person may apply to the comptroller for 1) a licence under the patent, or 2) an entry in the register to the effect that licences of right are available under the patent, or 3) where the applicant is a government department, for the grant of a licence to a specific person. The person must make the application on one or more of the grounds: that the patent is not being worked; the demand for the product of the patent is not being met; that the patent is being prevented or hindered from being worked; that a licence is being refused; that conditions imposed by the proprietor for the grant of a licence are unfairly prejudiced. In the event that the application is withdrawn this is advertised in the Official Gazette.
