Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

Any person may apply to the comptroller or the Court for the revocation of a patent on any of the following grounds: the invention was not a patentable invention; the patent was granted to a person or persons who were not the only ones entitled to be granted the patent; the specification of the patent is unclear; the matter disclosed in the specification extends beyond that disclosed in the application as filed; the protection conferred by the patent has been extended by an amendment which should not have been allowed. The applicant must provide a statement which sets out fully the grounds of revocation relied on, the facts relied upon and the relief sought. If the proprietor wishes to contest the application, he must within three months file a counterstatement. The action is then heard by the comptroller or the Court.
