Date of issue of the Official Journal (Patents) in which the notice is published.

code meaning

Any person may apply to the comptroller or the Court for the revocation of a patent on any one of the following grounds: the invention was not patentable; the patent was granted to a person or persons who were not the only ones entitled to be granted the patent; the specification of the patent is unclear; the matter disclosed in the specification extends beyond that disclosed in the application as filed; the protection conferred by the patent had been extended by an amendment which should not have been allowed. The proprietor may give notice to surrender the patent and this is advertised in the Official Gazette. Within three months of the advertisement any person may give notice of opposition to the surrender. In the event the offer to surrender is accepted by the comptroller this will terminate the proceedings under section 72.
