code meaning

Any person may apply to the comptroller for the revocation of a patent on any one of the following grounds: the invention was not a patentable invention; the patent was granted to a person or persons who were not the only ones entitled to be granted the patent; the specification of the patent is unclear; the matter disclosed in the specification extends beyond that disclosed in the application as filed; the protection conferred by the patent has been extended by an amendment which should not have been allowed. The applicant must provide a statement which sets out fully the grounds of revocation relied upon, the facts relied upon and the relief sought. If the proprietor wishes to contest the application, he must file a counterstatement within three months. The action is then heard by the comptroller. An appeal to the Patents Court may be made from any decision of the comptroller.
